IHMT | Competition | Full Professor

Pursuant to article 39 of the Statute of the University Teaching Career (ECDU), approved by Decree-Law no. 448/79 of 13 November amended and republished by Decree-Law no. 205/2009, published in the Official Gazette, 1st series, no. 168 of 31 August 2009, the Dean of the NOVA University of Lisbon, Doctor João Sàágua, by order of 15 May 2018, hereby informs that a competition based on qualifications is open for a period of 30 working days from the day immediately following the publication of this Notice in the Official Gazette, for the recruitment of 1 position for a Full Professor in the Biomedical Sciences Branch in the Entomology disciplinary area of the Institute of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine of this University

This competition is based on documented qualifications, is international and is governed by the provisions in articles 37 et seq. of said Statute, as well as by the Competitions Regulation of the University Teaching Career of the UNL (Regulation no. 3012/2015, published in the 2nd series of the Official Gazette, no. 58 of 24 March).

I - Admission requirements: Under the terms of article 40 of the ECDU, it is a requirement for the candidates for the competition in question, to have held a doctorate for more than five years and be a holder of the “agregação” title;

Other requirements:

- a) Candidates must have a PhD in Biomedical Sciences or related areas and a bachelor's or master's degree in Biology or Medicine.
- b) They must have a CV and extensive experience in Medical Entomology;
- c) Significant experience in teaching and research and extension work in the field, preferably in tropical countries;
- d) Experience in vectors that transmit tropical diseases, preferably in tropical countries
- e) Master Portuguese and English (spoken and written) at a level that allows them to provide teaching without any limitations of communication in these languages.

II - Presentation of the application: The candidates will present their applications, preferably in digital format, either in person or by mail, at the Institute of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine of the NOVA University of Lisbon, located at Rua da Junqueira, no. 100, 1349-008 Lisbon, in the form available at the Division of Human Resources Management and online at <http://www.ihmt.unl.pt>.

1. The application process must be accompanied by the following documentation:

- a) PhD certificate obtained more than five years ago in the disciplinary area of the competition;
- b) Certificate proving the title of aggregate professor;
- c) 7 Copies of the candidate's curriculum vitae, in digital format (flash drive) or printed;
- d) 7 Copies of each of the published works mentioned in the curriculum vitae, printed or, preferably, in digital format (flash drive), in particular the most representative ones, as regards their contribution to the development and evolution of the area of the competition;
- e) If the applicant is not of Portuguese nationality or of a country whose official language is Portuguese, internationally recognised certification of the command of the Portuguese language is required at a level that allows them to teach;
- f) Cover Letter.

2. Evidence of the possession of the general recruitment requirements in public functions may be replaced by a statement on the form referred to in no. II above, available from the Division of Human Resources Management of the Institute of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine of the NOVA University of Lisbon and online at <http://www.ihmt.unl.pt>.
3. Applications duly accompanied by the documents mentioned in item II above must be submitted within 30 working days from the day immediately following the publication of this Notice in the Official Gazette.
4. The absence of any supporting documents which cannot be obtained on the Division's own motion will determine the rejection of the application.
5. Candidates must organise their CV according to the systematics of point III of the Notice.

III – Evaluation Criteria: The criteria, indicators and weighting approved by the jury for the evaluation and ranking of the listed candidates, are the following:

1. Scientific Performance, Development and Innovation (40%):

1.1. Capacity for inclusion in national and international funding systems (with emphasis on the EU Framework Programs), as reflected in funded projects that the candidates coordinate (0 - 25)

1.2. Capacity for inclusion in national and international funding systems (with emphasis on the EU Framework Programs), as reflected in funded projects in which the candidates are responsible for the participation of the Institution to which they belong (0 - 10)

1.3. Management/Coordination/Leadership of scientific research teams (Units, Centres and Laboratories, NGOs, Scientific Societies and others), scientific events and scientific journals (0 - 15)

1.4 Scientific production with particular focus on authoring and co-authoring of: (0 - 20)

- a) Articles published in indexed international journals;
- b) Books or chapters of scientific books;
- c) Patents;
- d) Presentations at international and national congresses;
- e) Other scientific dissemination and extension activities.

1.5 Capacity to guide postgraduate and undergraduate work, reflected in guidance and co-supervision at post-doctoral, doctoral, masters, advanced study or postgraduate and undergraduate level (0 - 15);

1.6. Participation in: (0 - 15)

- a) Scientific commissions;
- b) Organization of congresses and other national and international scientific meetings;
- c) Review of articles in journals or papers in scientific meetings;
- d) Evaluation panels of the educational, technological and scientific system;
- e) Activities by governmental request;
- f) Networks.

(100=40%)

2. Teaching Ability (30%):

2.1 - Coordination of academic/educational projects: courses (master's degree, postgraduate and others), study plans and programs having impact on the teaching/learning process, in the scientific/academic area related to the competition (0 -15)

2.2 - Participation in academic/educational projects: courses (master's degree, postgraduate and others), study plans and programs having impact on the teaching/learning process, in the scientific/academic area related to the competition (0 - 10)

2.3 - Coordination and participation in international academic/teaching projects (0-10)

2.4 - Production of teaching/learning materials: manuals, handouts and scientific/pedagogical articles that should fall within the scientific area to which the competition relates (0 - 20)

2.5 - Intervention and stimulation of learning by means of participation in an educational management body in the institutions to which the candidate belongs or used to belong (0 - 10)

2.6 - Teaching activity (hours and diversity) (0 - 20)

2.7 - Training for the acquisition and development of skills in the teaching area (0 - 5)

2.8 - Participation in panels for academic examinations (more highly valued in the case of oral testing) and teaching, research and senior technical career competitions related to scientific activities (0 - 10)

3. Other relevant activities: (30%)

3.1 - Cover letter (0 - 10)

3.2 - University extension activities, including: (0 - 45)

a) Organization of specialization and updating courses;

b) Practice of consulting activities;

c) Provision of services to the community.

3.3 - University Management Activity, specifically participation in management bodies, the occupation of management positions and coordination of scientific and educational activities and active participation in the creation and management of libraries, laboratories and other relevant infrastructure and services of the Academic Institutions to which they belong. (0 - 45)

4. In the evaluation of applications, special emphasis will be placed on the works and activities carried out in the area of the competition in tropical regions, in the five years prior to the date of its opening.

V - Evaluation of applications:

1. After the deadline for applications, the jury gathers for evaluation and ordering of candidates.
2. Based on the assessment of the curricula, their suitability for the scientific area in which the competition is open, the other competition pieces and the classifications awarded, according to the criteria and weighting provided for in no. III above, the jury accepts the application of those candidates with a final classification, in absolute merit, equal or superior to 50, or excludes them, if they have a final classification of less than 50.
3. Once the candidates are listed, based on the above classifications, the jury presents their written opinion with the order of the admitted candidates.
4. If a candidate is not admitted, he or she will be notified, to give his or her opinion, under the terms of the Code of Administrative Procedure.
5. The ordering of the listed candidates is done by a vote of the members, respecting the order presented in the document referred to in item 3 above, pursuant to article 16, paragraph 11, a) to f) of the University Teaching Career Competitions Regulation at the UNL.
